1	Mezi námi, o.p.s.	48,750 CZK	Fund equipment and furniture for their intergenerational house.	Mezi námi has been connecting seniors and children across the country since 2013. They do this by linking senior care facilities with schools and kindergartens, organizing activities, supporting senior volunteering, and running a community center for older adults. Through these activities, they help reduce loneliness and build stronger connections across generations.
2	SOS dětské vesničky, z.s.	150,000 CZK	Fund equipment for the new building of their crisis center.	SOS Children Villages provide support to vulnerable children, help prevent the separation of children from their families, offer assistance to children in crises, support foster families, and socially disadvantaged young people transitioning to independent living. Its programs assist several thousand children per year.
3	Centrum pro dětský sluch Tamtam, o.p.s.	100,000 CZK	Fund purchasing of sensory tools for children with hearing disabilities.	Tamtam is a nationwide non-profit organisation founded in 1990, providing comprehensive support to children with hearing impairment and their families from birth to 18 years of age.
4	Česká unie neslyšících, z.u.	8,388 CZK	Fund flooring material for children with hearing impairment.	The Czech Union of the Deaf has been providing services to clients with hearing loss since 1990. For deaf seniors, we run activities focused on memory training and creative work, senior exercise classes, and assistance with PCs, mobile phones, and tablets, including support with using these devices.
5	Dobré víly dětem z.s.	170,000 CZK	Fund travel costs, volunteer coordination, and school supplies.	Dobré víly dětem has been helping children in children's group homes since 2015, they work with 19 group homes across the Czech Republic. Some of the activities they do during visits are helping children with schoolwork, giving them individual attention, and playing with them. They also organize summer camps and educational events for children.
6	Nadace Leontinka	46,224 CZK	Fund equipment and aids for children with visual and combined disabilities.	Nadace Leontinka's mission is to support children and young adults with visual impairment. They do this by focusing on providing early intervention services for children

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				from birth to the age of seven. They help children in five locations across the Czech republic.
7	Nadační fond Harmonie	50,000 CZK	Fund event expenses for a children's annual orchestra concert for children of unfavourable socioeconomic background.	Established in 2009 and inspired by the renowned El Sistema project. We provide free music tuition, including the use of instruments, to all children, regardless of their skills, background, or social status.
8	Péče bez překážek, z. S.	100,000 CZK	Fund swimming venue expenses for children with special needs.	Péče bez překážek provides social services for children with disabilities since 2017. They focus on organizing rehabilitative swimming, providing physiotherapy advice, and organizing educational courses for parents.
9	Sdílení o.p.s.	39,109 CZK	Fund equipment for palliative care at home	Sdílení helps people who care for their ill, elderly, or dying loved ones at home. Every day, their care assistants, nurses, doctors and social workers visit the homes of clients and patients in Telč and the surrounding region, providing support to families who have chosen to care for their loved ones at home.
10	Centrum integrace dětí a mládeže, z.s.	100,000 CZK	Fund psychological support for parents and therapeutic support for children in need	CID - Center for Integration of Children and Youth has been helping healthy children and too children with any kind of disability for 35 years, as well as their parents and seniors. CID contributes to improving the conditions for the integration of children and youth with health and social disadvantages.
11	Za sklem o.s.	100,000 CZK	Fund therapy equipment for children and adolescents with Autism.	<i>Za sklem helps people on the autism spectrum, with the aim of enabling them to live, learn and work in a way that is in line with their needs and preferences. They provide therapies targeted at sensory motor development, development of social and communication skills and training for independent functioning.</i>
12	DownSyndrom CZ, z.s.	50,000 CZK	Fund IT and household equipment, and half-year of rent expenses.	This organization has been supporting children and adults with Down syndrome and their families since 1996 through counselling, education, leisure activities, family events, and inclusion-focused programs. They promote awareness, advocate for equal opportunities, and help create a society where everyone can live a fulfilling and meaningful life.
13	Nadace Dagmar a Václava Havlových VIZE 97	100,000 CZK	Fund part of their prevention project "Stop before you hit" with expenses of therapy, materials, and the renovation of their therapy room.	The Stop Before You Hit project plays a crucial preventive role by reducing the risk of domestic violence. The program contributes not only to the protection of potential victims but also to the long-term well-being of entire families.

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14	ACORUS, z.ú.	60,000 CZK	Fund Furniture equipment for their domestic violence shelter for women and children.	ACORUS's goal is to help individuals and families regain safety, stability, and the opportunity to live a life free from violence. Since 1997, ACORUS has been providing support to people affected by domestic violence through a network of registered social services, accredited programmes, specialised projects, and prevention activities.
15	PFERDA z.ú.	100,000 CZK	Fund modern cleaning equipment to employ people with disabilities.	Pferda supports people with disabilities and other disadvantaged groups in employment, education, and independent living.
16	Charita Nový Hrozenkov	100,000 CZK	Fund outpatient, and residential help to the terminally ill, injured, and elderly and Funding of home health aid equipment	This organization has been operating in the far mountainous area of Wallachia near the border with Slovakia since 1992. Their main mission is to give people in need the possibility to stay at home despite their deteriorated health, and to help them live with dignity in the environment they are used to.
